MONTREAL, November 16, 2013 — The magnificent new space in the Port Royal at 1455 Sherbrooke St. West is the latest of Samuel Lallouz's artistic adventures in Montreal. For more than thirty years he has been introducing Montrealers to Canadian and international contemporary art, fostering young artists and offering professional services to collectors. The new gallery, specially designed by architects Andrea Wolff and Jodi Ostrzega, has display areas, both spacious and intimate, as well as a project room for experimental work.

The opening on November 28 will feature a new photographic exhibition by Toronto-based Janieta Eyre *I should have begun with this*. The artist will be present, as will New York-based Monika Weiss to "inhabit" one of her installations and present a new video. Singer-songwriter JF Robitaille, whose recent video *Black and White* was inspired by Janieta Eyre's work, will perform.

Gracing the new gallery space as well are works by gallery artists Bärbel Rothhaar from Berlin and Osnat Bar-Or from Israel. Rarely seen pieces by Joseph Beuys, Jean-Paul Riopelle and Paul-Émile Borduas are also on show, along with a work of German super-star Anselm Kiefer.

The new gallery thus continues the Lallouz tradition of presenting unusual and provocative artwork for Montreal art lovers.
